

Furniture Restoration in Orange County

Recently, the Better Business Bureau received various complaints from persons who have felt wronged by the firms that they hired to undertake [furniture repair in Orange County](#). Chief among the complaints were accusations of damaging antique furniture, such as scuff marks, scratches, stains, and even cracks in the wood. Unfortunately, this happens more often than it should, which is a shame. For [California custom cabinet](#) makers and restorers, accusations like these can be the kiss of death to their business.

More than merely decorative, antique furniture is an investment that requires a great deal of care, as its physical condition is used as the basis for its overall value, among other things. Part of protecting your investment (or alternatively, your inheritance) is ensuring that your furniture is in as good a condition as possible. However, this can mean anything from restoration, which entails making the item look the way it did when it was new; or conservation, which means ensuring that the item is protected against further deterioration.

As you can imagine, this can be very delicate work. The chance of ruining a piece during the process of restoration is very high if it is left in the wrong hands. Making the decision to have a piece repaired or restored versus leaving it in its current condition can be a bind for many an antique collector. Too often, the small things that give the item character can disappear entirely after restoration. One must consider whether or not the piece will benefit, not just appearance-wise but in monetary terms, from making certain changes.

For example, for pieces that have cabinets, one can opt to change worn-out or broken door handles. Furniture that has drawers, such as a bureau or a tallboy, can come with missing or mismatched drawer pulls that need to be replaced. Another thing to consider is whether or not the restoration is appropriate for the age and for the amount of use that it's going to get on a daily basis.

This is why the sole criteria many collectors use when looking for firms specializing in [furniture restoration in Orange County](#), is a reputation for excellent craftsmanship. What people are looking for is a highly respected name in the business of [furniture refinishing in Orange County](#), California which offers full service antique restoration. They should employ highly-skilled craftsmen, who take the job beyond merely restoring functionality to a particular piece, and instead see it as an art-form. You should be able to choose to have the work done on-site, whether at your home or office, or have it finished at their workshop. Their services should include French polish, hand waxing, the application of stains, lacquers, and other finishes, among other things, to [cabinet refinishing in Orange County](#), from built-in kitchen units to stand alone furniture such as sideboards and china cabinets. They should be able to do away with water marks, dirt, minor burns from cigarettes, and the general marks of daily use and abuse by previous and current owners.
