

Preparing for a Sonoma Winery Tour

Wine tours, after all, are intended for people to taste the wines. Not just two or three glasses of wine, it could be more than 10 or 15 varieties or even beyond that. You will taste wines. Trips are conducted in the wine country for customers to test sampling wines. Wine country isn't really a country all the time but just a region where wine grapes grow. [Wine tours in Sonoma](#) or France wine country trips let the tasters experience hundreds of different flavors of wine from hundreds of wineries.

Here's a quick lesson for amateurs who don't know anything about wine. Notice the different colors of wines. In most cases, we see a dark red color and loose consistency. Focus on the color of the wines. The deeper the color, the heavier the wine is. We say dry wine if we refer to brand that has less sugar residual, hence, not so sweet.

Wine tours are very exciting. Not only do tasters drink the best wines, they also get the chance to meet the winemakers. Imagine shaking the hands that made your lustful wine. The whole-day tours are sponsored by organizers who introduce tasters to different winemakers while actually endorsing selected specific brands.

Remember that wine tours are not all the time free. Wineries which have several different wines sometimes ask for a tasting fee. But all the same, tasters can only sip an amount of the wines whether it's free or not. If you prefer staying sober for the whole day, don't gulp down all the wine samples. Just feel the wine in your mouth, gargle a little but not too much since wine has alcohol, then just spit it out. This way, you don't have to worry about discharging a considerable amount of disgusting digested wines. But if you're the person who really wants to drink a full glass, try to spot some wineries which allow tasters party at the end of the tour.

Now, you are ready for that much-awaited wine tour wherein you can taste what John Stuart Blackie referred to as drink of the gods.
