The clock in front of the Grand Central facade holds the world's largest example of Tiffany glass and is surrounded by sculptures carved by the John Donnelly Company of Minerva, Hercules, and Mercury.

Chrysler Building

The Chrysler Building is an Art Deco skyscraper in New York and the world's tallest brick building.

The building's classic architecture has a feature also evident on Chrysler autos. In 2007, the American Institute of Architects chose it as the ninth "America's Favorite Architecture".
